## SOUTH CAROLINA RESIDENCY CERTIFICATION - INDEPENDENT

The Palmetto Fellows, LIFE, and HOPE Scholarship Programs and the SC Tuition Grant Program require that recipients certify they are South Carolina residents in order to receive the scholarship. The initial determination of one's resident status is made at the time of admission and the burden of proof is provided by the student applicant.
