\*Generally, these are accepted only if taken during the first two years of college; however, the registrar's office may give special permission to transfer a maximum of twelve of these hours after the student has accumulated 68 total hours (Southern Wesleyan University and transfer). Transferring more than twelve semester hours after this point will require special approval by the Academic Council.
