Showers of blessing quench spiritual thirst

For several years, the lack of rain has caused a severe drought in the Southeast unlike any period in recent history.

The rivers and lakes receded to levels that turned waterfront property into pastureland. Plants and trees became parched and dry. Many cities and towns experienced the lack of water in crisis proportions. The dire need for water created a thirst for rain and relief from the destructive dryness that was everywhere.

David writes in Psalm 143 that his heart, too, was dry and parched because of the circumstances that crushed him on every side. His enemies were many and the pressures of constant conflict and trouble caused his spirit to become faint and weakened. He writes, "...my soul thirsts for you like a parched land." In the middle of his desert and in the midst of the dryness of his

life, David had a deep thirst that was unquenchable and cried out to the Lord for relief.

Whether it is in our individual lives, within a church or even at a university, there are those times of great thirst and a desire for the spirit of God to flow within us. The circumstances that seem to press us from every side create a parched and thirsty faith that only God can relieve and refresh. Our times are troubled and have all the characteristics of a drought of the spirit. No person, ruler or organization has the words that can satisfy our deep inner thirst for relief.

The same David that cried out to God in his thirst is the same David that wrote "God leads me beside the still waters and restores my soul." God never promised his people a life without difficulties and we know that is true. But he did promise that in all things he would quench our thirst and fill us to overflowing with his grace and the cool refreshing of his spirit.

Throughout its 103-year history, our university has experienced both deserts and times of showers and restoration. From generation to generation, we have witnessed this dryness being quenched by the outpouring of God's blessings and provision. Through it all, as parched and dry as it may be, the God of the heavens has opened the floodgates and brought rain – cool refreshing rain – to remind us of Him and His unfailing promises.

The old gospel song says, "There shall be showers of blessing, this is the promise of love." The psalmist speaks of these same refreshing showers and closes his writings with the word "selah," which means that we should all pause to think about this truth.

Perhaps we should do just that. As I look out my window these days, it has started to rain ... selah.

Chapel organ campaign hits the right notes

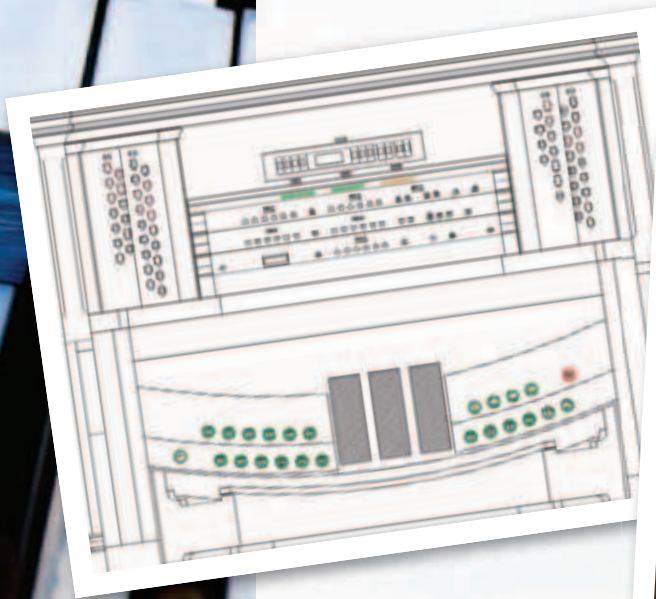

Team bounces down to Dominican Republic

The SWU Men's basketball team headed to the Dominican Republic for a mission trip, the vision of head coach Charles Wimphrie.

Assistant Coach Charles Holland and 10 players made the trip.

"God opened my eyes to many things while in the Dominican Republic," Wimphrie said. "I was able to see the harsh conditions of a third world country through God's eyes. I am thankful that God chose me to lead such a life-changing experience for my team. I look forward to another mission trip in the near future."

The team faced many adjustments during visit to a third world country, including water and sewer restrictions. Daily treks to sugarcane villages and orphanages gave an insight to true happiness. The children of the villages greeted the group with open arms and were overjoyed to have people play with them and give them quality time. The team was able to share the gospel through an interpreter and several children gave their lives to God.

The SWU team played five basketball games. Each opposing team had one or two professional players. The games were in gyms where having a scoreboard was a luxury and air

conditioning was out of the question. There was even one game in which the score was kept on a flipchart and the time was kept on a cell phone.

SWU won four of the five games. The team usually held a clinic prior to the games for about 100 kids. One pro player gave a SWU player an autographed jersey and a child from the Dominican Republic gave another SWU player a silver necklace with a cross. These were luxuries from people who often don't have food every day.

Assistant Coach Holland said the trip opened the eyes of the players and allowed the team to bond.



"I have never felt so much love at each turn for mankind and God, which helped remind us that the world is never just about us but about sharing through the love of God," he said.

SWU athletic teams win NAIA Scholar Team Awards

Southern Wesleyan University closed out the 2008-09 athletic year with five athletic teams receiving the NAIA Scholar Team Award.

Men's & Women's Cross Country, Golf, Women's Soccer and Volleyball were the five teams that represented Southern Wesleyan. In order to receive the award, the team must

achieve a grade point average of 3.0 or higher for the academic year. Men's Cross Country had the highest grade point average of the five SWU teams on the NAIA Scholar Team with a 3.26, while Women's Cross Country was just behind them with a 3.23 grade point average. Rounding out the grade point averages for Southern Wesleyan were Golf (3.18),

Volleyball (3.12) and Women's Soccer (3.07)

"It is awesome to see these five teams recognized for their hard work in the classroom," said SWU Director of Athletics Chris Williams. "I see this as the beginning of a standard that every Southern Wesleyan athletic team will aspire to achieve."

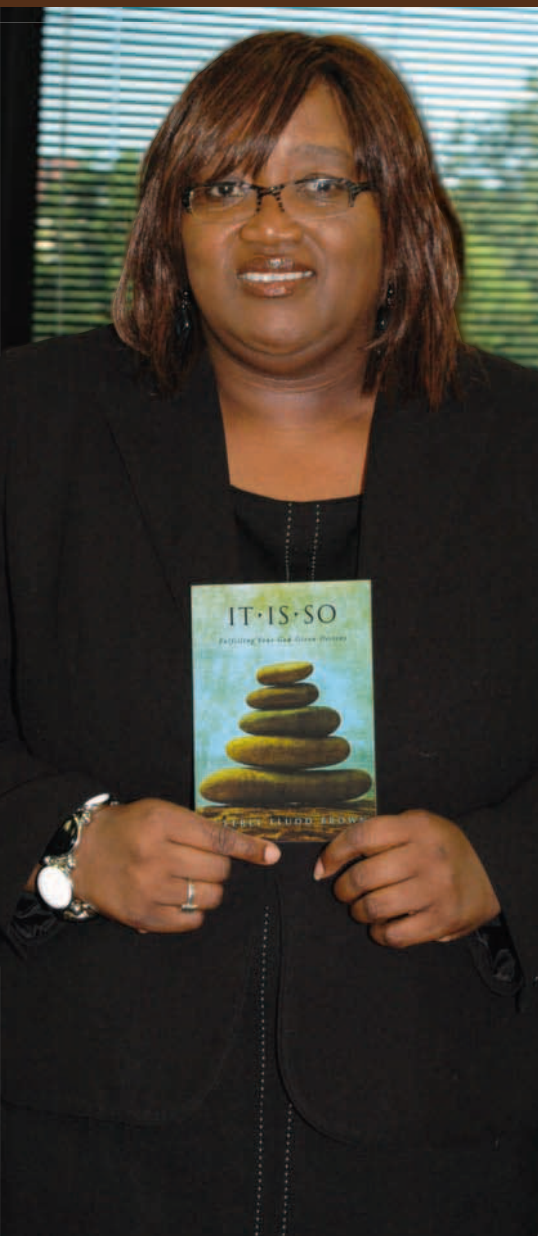

Business student pens inspirational book

During the journey down life's road, there are often rough spots and detours.

For Beverly Fludd Brown, a business student enrolled at Southern Wesleyan's Charleston location, God used these challenges to help her focus on her destiny and to provide encouragement to others. That encouragement came in the form of a book, which she recently published. "It is So – Fulfilling your God Given Destiny," is a book of Brown's poetry and words of inspiration that offers readers hope based on God's promises.

A Mount Pleasant native, Brown graduated from Wando High School.

Although she wanted to enter a college after high school, Brown devoted herself to her job and raising her children. When her children were older, she applied to Southern Wesleyan and was accepted.

"At that time, SWU was one of the few colleges here in Charleston that had adult classes," Brown said, adding that the business

degree program fit perfectly into her busy schedule. Brown is a supervisor of registration at the Medical University of South Carolina, where she has been employed for 17 years.

"My book is basically about some of the struggles that I have had to overcome to be able to realize I have destiny and purpose in God," Brown said. Just as she learned to understand her true value as a human being, Brown felt led to help others understand that they have value.

"It was a few years before it was the right season for it to be published. I believe that we have to be led by God when it comes to things like that, so it was 2007 before it actually took off," said Brown, whose book was released by Tate Publishing and reached the shelves of Barnes and Noble, Books-a-Million and Christian bookstores in the Charleston area. "It is So" is also available online through Amazon.com and other sources.

"It has always been a desire of mine to write," Brown said. "I used to go in different stores and dream of seeing my book in the store. Now, to be able to see it, I can't even explain how it feels."

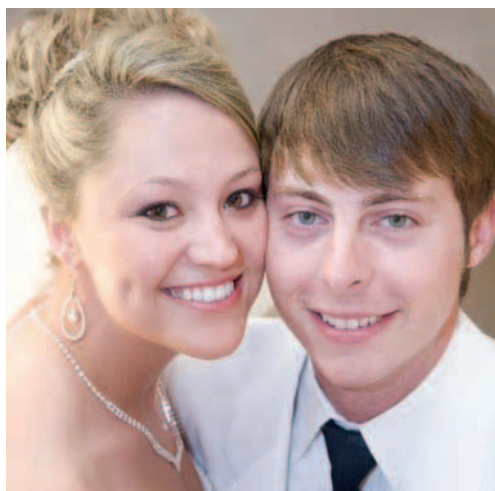

SWU celebrates 96-year-old graduates

In 1913 Southern Wesleyan University was in her seventh year of existence.

On July 29, 1913, two mothers went into labor on the same day and both gave birth to baby girls, Sue Binns and Willyne Correll. In 1930, the two girls met during roll call of class on the campus of the university. Sue and Willyne quickly learned they shared the same birthday and a friendship began.

Recently, Sue and Willyne celebrated their ninety-sixth birthday and learned they share more than a birthday, they share the honor of being recognized as the oldest female alumnae of SWU. A group of faculty, staff, administrators, alumni and friends gathered in Charlotte,

N.C., to celebrate. The Alumni Association, along with SWU President David Spittal, recognized these ladies and expressed great appreciation for their faithfulness to the university.

A little history of the 1913 babies that grew into two of SWU's finest alumnae begins with Sue Binns Black, mother of two boys. Her oldest and self proclaimed "wisest," is Watson H. and the baby of the family is SWU religion faculty member Dr. Robert Black.

Sue has many fond memories of her days in Central. The love of her life, Watson C. Black, chose the front of the administration building, Grimes Hall, to ask Sue to marry him. She recalls he did not kneel down, but he was very sincere and she said yes.

When asked about their first date she smiled and replied, "We had to be so secretive that I don't remember the first date."

Sue and Watson served in ministry in the local church for many years and served in leadership for an additional 14 years as District Superintendent in The Wesleyan Church of North Carolina West. When asked about her favorite scripture of the Bible, Sue said, "The entire Bible is so sacred, I have a hard time choosing a favorite verse. However; if I must highlight one, I would choose John 3:16."

Willyne Correll Sanders is the daughter of W.D. Corell who has been noted in many writings as a churchman, businessman and Southern gentleman. Willyne's father was one of the first two graduates of the college's theological program in 1911. He served as pastor and evangelist in the South Carolina Conference.

Willyne is the only person to have ever attended elementary, secondary and junior college on the campus of Southern Wesleyan University. She was full of memories and contagious laughter when she remembered her time at "campus hill." Willyne also remembers the tragic death of

her mother in a car accident and the loss of her father because of leukemia.

She recalls getting in trouble for drinking "Wesleyan Whiskey," also known as Coca-Cola. (During the early days of the school, drinking soft drinks was against the rules.)

Willyne highlighted her friendship with Sue and expressed her secret to living 96 years. She said that living a Christian life, eating vegetables, working in the yard and not sitting around in a chair contribute to her being so mobile that at 96 years old she still drives to town, works in her flowerbeds and spends special time with Sugar and Sweetie, her Pomeranian dogs.

"Sugar and Sweetie, they love me and I love them. I could not live without them," she said.

Student keeps promise to himself: learn

One student has found education, friendship, Christian support and healing while attending Southern Wesleyan University in North Augusta.

For years, Jasper Brown said he had found excuses not to complete his higher education.

"I had promised myself that I was going to finish college. My girls had finished, my wife had gone on to trade school, everybody was established and here I was with a high school diploma at 52 years old," he said.

So, in July of 2004, Brown began his higher education at Southern Wesleyan University. So far, he has earned his associate's of science in

business and his bachelor's degree in management. Next, Brown will tackle the master's in management degree.

"I'm looking forward to finishing the master's program," he said. "The master's is like putting the icing on a cake."

As an adult student heading back to the classroom, Brown said at first he was worried about going back to school.

"I was nervous, scared to death. I didn't know what it was going to be like," he said. "It was hard, that first couple of weeks. Then everything just began to fall in place." Brown describes his lack of a college education as a wound and says that his classes at Southern Wesleyan University have healed that wound.

"What I've found is a school that embraces you, encourages you, that counsels," Brown said. "The most important thing is the Christian perspective. I had tried going to college before and it just didn't seem to work out. I think the one thing that was missing was that Christian perspective."

Brown works at the Savannah River Site near Aiken, S.C.

"I began my employment there in 1980 as a clerk," Brown said. Since then, he has been a mechanic, supervisor, facility maintenance manager and now is a liaison between existing services at SRS and new projects being established in the community. He has worked there nearly 30 years.

"My career at SRS is about to end," Brown said, referring to his upcoming retirement. "I believe that completing the master's program

will open the door for some other opportunities."

One of the skills Brown has taken from his classrooms to his workplace is improved writing ability.

"One of my very first instructors was an English professor. Now writing has become a way of life for me," Brown said. "I have grown quite fond of writing. It has been a big help in how I communicate as a manager."

The professors in the adult program at Southern Wesleyan University were inspiring to Brown, he said. "Since they had actual career experiences that they could share, it made what they were teaching come to life," he said. "This has been just a wonderful opportunity."

Sharing class time and study time together gives classmates a special bond. At Southern Wesleyan, Brown says he has made friends that will last a lifetime.

"Each one of my classmates brings something different to the table," he said. "We share everything from A to Z."

Brown is the elder of two sons. He was born in Ward, S.C., in Edgefield County. He and his wife of 20 years, Sarah, have two daughters and attend Mt. Anna Missionary Baptist Church in Aiken.

Brown is eager for others to experience higher education as he has.

"Right now it's second nature to encourage others to come back to school. Anybody can make an excuse and that's normally what it is, an excuse. We can all find some excuse."

But pursuing his college education was a promise he needed to keep for himself, he said, "This was something that I owed Jasper."

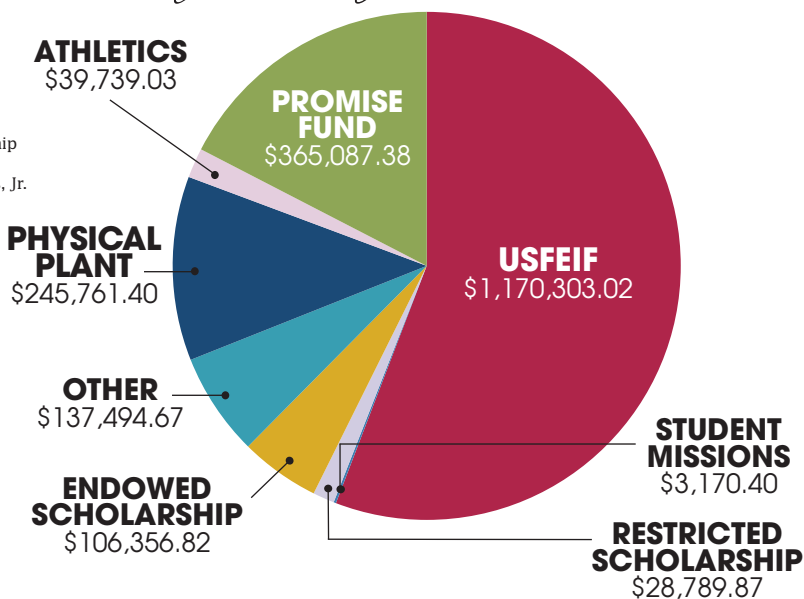
