Update on challenge to fuel Promise Fund


As of Feb. 21, 2011, the university has raised \$236,978 toward the \$450,000 goal for Promise Fund giving, which is a little over half way!

New degree to prepare education leaders

Southern Wesleyan University is now offering a new master's degree for educators who plan to become administrators.

The university's new Master of Education in Administration and Supervision, launching in February 2011, will fill a need in the state of South Carolina for highly qualified professionals in school administration and supervision, according to Dr. Paul Shotsberger, dean of Southern Wesleyan's School of Education.

The 12-course program will provide the opportunity for advanced certification for administrators at the elementary or secondary level.

Shotsberger said Southern Wesleyan offers the highest quality instructors who have academic expertise and experience, as well as necessary resources for students to qualify for any administration or supervision career path they may pursue.

The new curriculum will cover topics including educational



leadership, school operations management, public and community relations, ethics and advanced educational research.

"This new program includes three practicum opportunities in addition to a capstone internship, all of which can be completed at your school without requiring you to leave your current position," Shotsberger said.

The program will be offered at Southern Wesleyan's five learning centers throughout the state: Central, Charleston, Columbia, Greenville and North Augusta. 
Musicians plan to honor retiring SWU president

University student-athletes build teamwork, character

Southern Wesleyan University's athletic department has received the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics Champions of Character award for the past several years.

This award is given to NAIA schools that meet certain standards set forth by the national office. To be considered a Champions of Character institution, schools must complete a form which is later reviewed by a team directed by NAIA Vice President of Champions of Character Rob Haworth.

"The Champions of Character program supports performance-driven athletics while defining expectations and standards that drive successful teams and athletic departments," Haworth said.

The mission of Champions of Character is to restore character values and raise a generation of students who understand and demonstrate in everyday decisions integrity, respect, responsibility, sportsmanship and servant leadership.

The Warrior men's soccer team opened this year's service opportunities by volunteering their time at the local Clemson Community Care in early August.

"Doing community service during preseason is always a great way to build unity within the team. This past year we went to Clemson Community Care and put packages of food together. I was amazed at how hard the team worked to accomplish something that went beyond them," head men's soccer coach Camilo Rodriguez said.

The men's soccer team then assisted members of The Lot Project with a basketball tournament. The studentathletes assisting in officiating basketball games created to bring in some local kids in areas of need. The squad also helped set up the event and interacted with those in attendance. The Lot Project serves communities across the state and works in part by mentoring teens and feeding, clothing and providing shelter for those in need.

The softball, men and women's basketball

and baseball teams have all been active in reaching out to the community. The Southern Wesleyan softball team partnered with the Pickens County Habitat for Humanity in Apostles' Build 2010. In an Apostles' Build, the mission is for 12 local churches or organizations to partner to raise money and provide the labor and prayer support to build a Habitat for Humanity house.

"Habitat for Humanity is a great opportunity for our student-athletes to make a difference in our community, and to gain experience beyond the classroom and the field. It also helps to equip our student-athletes for service and to transform their world, which is a key part of the mission of Southern Wesleyan University," head softball coach Ed Deugan said.

The men's basketball team was busy in the fall as they visited the Frazee Dream House, participated in a Memory Walk and donated backboards to a local elementary school. The women's basketball team visited Spearman Elementary School and participated in their after-school program assisting with arts and crafts and reading to the students.

Head baseball coach Mike Gillespie had his team involved in the country Santa Project that has been helping needy families in the foothills of South Carolina since 1978. Last year the organization helped more than 3,200 children in the Upstate area experience Christmas. This year the Southern Wesleyan baseball program helped Country Santa by collecting toys and money prior to Christmas, then bagging and distributing the toys. The team started their mission back in October and collected \$1,250 for the project, which includes toys and monetary gifts.

The Warrior athletics programs continue to work in the community throughout the rest of the spring semester. Southern Wesleyan was recognized with a 5-Star Award from the NAIA for their efforts in 2009-2010, as SWU was located in the upper 70th percentile of schools throughout the nation.

Southern Wesleyan group visits Holy Land

On a pilgrimage to the Holy Land in November, a group of Southern Wesleyan University alumni and friends traveled far from home, but drew closer to God.

The group, led by Dr. Jim Bross Sr., included Jim Bross Jr., Sheila Crawford, Valerie Ramsey and myself (all SWU alumni), Annette Carrigan, Ruth Harris, Pam and the Reverend Phillip McAlister, and Joyce Young left Douglas Airport in Charlotte, N.C., just before noon on Nov. 29, 2010, and arrived in Tel Aviv, Israel, late afternoon on Nov. 30. We spent our first night in Israel in Netanya and were joined by a group of 16 other tourists from Dallas, Tex.

The next morning we made our way up the coastline to Caesarea, constructed by Herod the Great in 20 B.C. and named for Augustus Caesar. It was the official residence of the Roman governors, including Pontius Pilate. There we viewed both ancient ruins and a renovated Roman amphitheater still used today. One of the ruins we saw was the room where the Apostle Paul was held and talked with King Agrippa and Bernice during his imprisonment before being sent to Tarsus.

We then traveled to Mt. Carmel and visited a monastery on the traditional site where Elijah had God bring down fire on his watered altars, pitting the power of his God against the Baal priests and their god. Our next visits were to Megiddo, where the Battle of Armageddon will be fought, and to Cana, where Jesus performed his first miracle.

The next five days we trekked from early mornings to late afternoons seeing as much of the Holy Land as we could see. Crossing the Sea of Galilee by boat, visiting the site of the Mount of the Beatitudes, the Mount where the loaves and fishes were multiplied and the shore of Galilee where Peter was told by Christ to feed his sheep, then renewing our baptismal vows in the Jordan River brought joy to our hearts.

Exploring the sites of Nazareth and then via Bet Shean traveling through the Jordan Valley to Bethlehem, we caught our first sights of the Judean desert and Jerusalem, the city built on a hill. It was an easy one and a half hour trip by bus, but my mind tried to imagine how hard it must have been for Joseph and Mary, the soon-to-be parents of our Lord, to make that long trip on foot through the desert to reach the city where their lineages began.

Bethlehem held special sites for us: the Church of the Nativity, marking the spot of Christ's birth, and the Shepherd's Field. Singing Christmas carols there in the Shepherd's Field brought a keen sense of awe and wonder to us. The Palestinian encasement of the city saddened us. The inhabitants of Bethlehem have to enter and exit the city through the Palestinian checkpoints.

In and close to Jericho we saw Elisha's Spring, Jesus' Mount of Temptation and the traditional sycamore tree that Zacchaeus climbed to see our Lord. We traveled to Masada, Qumran, Bethany (Lazarus' city), and to the Dead Sea, passing the site of Jesus' baptism by John in the Jordan River.

Our next two days were spent in and around Jerusalem. We drove to the top of the Mount of Olives to look over the city and went to the place of the Ascension, and visited a garden tomb that some propose to have been where Jesus was buried and resurrected. We visited the Upper Room, the Rock of Agony, upon which Jesus prayed the night before his arrest, and the Garden of Gethsemane, where we had the Lord's Supper in remembrance of Him.

Upon leaving Jerusalem, we visited the western wall of the temple now known as the Wailing Wall. As I placed my hand on the wall to join those praying there, I felt the witness of the Holy Spirit as if it were an electrical shock. His power permeated the premises. I felt that it was His wall, His holy place; I felt His validating our pilgrimage to His Holy Land. What an awesome place to be, what a glorifying experience!

Pausing to celebrate and moving forward

Achieving a challenging 10-year goal is a real missionary milestone for Dave and Donna Tolan.

Ten years ago the Tolans, Missions Mobilizers at SWU, set a goal that from 2000 to 2010, more than 100 SWU students or alumni will have served, or be under appointment to serve, as missionaries for six months or longer. They divided the goal into two parts: 50 by 2006 and 100 by 2010. When the Tolans set this goal, they said it seemed impossible.

"However, we were convinced this goal was God-ordained and knew it would only be reached through His power." Dave Tolan said.

In November, during Southern Wesleyan's annual missions conference on the university's main campus in Central, the university celebrated. In chapel was a missionary roll call, with an accompanying PowerPoint, of 100 names.

"From approximately 10 missionaries in the 1990's to more than 100 in the last 10 years is an amazing accomplishment," Tolan said. "These 100 represent more than 150 years of service in almost 40 different countries! Currently, 38 are either on the field or under appointment and raising support to depart soon."

Now that the university has celebrated, the focus will move to setting a new goal.

"We must move ahead! We must refocus," Tolan said.

Southern Weslevan University had 100 missionaries from 2000 to 2010. These are alumni who, within the past 10 years, have served as missionaries for six months or longer or have been appointed and are raising support to serve.

Southern Wesleyan University President Dr. David Spittal said that Jennings demonstrated leadership and a strong commitment to the university and its Christ-centered mission. Spittal also expressed appreciation for Jennings' supportiveness during his early years as president.

"Those early days were difficult for the university and the temptation to surrender was always present, but his steadfastness and encouragement helped me draw strength and courage to pursue God's plan for this special place," Spittal said.

Jennings practiced family medicine in Gastonia, N.C., and later served as a physician for the Veteran's Administration. He also worked as a medical missionary for The Wesleyan Church in India and Sierra Leone, West Africa. He served the church in local, district and general boards of administration. Jennings is a veteran of both World War II and the Korean War, having served in the U.S. Army and receiving four Bronze Stars, as well as several medals of commendation.

Jennings is survived by his wife, Mary Faith Jennings; two sons, Donald Jennings of Tallahassee, Fla.; David Jennings of Lowell, N.C.; two daughters, Janene Bryson of Brevard, N.C.; Ellen Belliveau of Highland, Md.; and 11 grandchildren. passion for all levels of education is the driving force for Jim Shelton.

The regional director for Southern Wesleyan University's adult and graduate studies program in Central, S.C., Shelton is adamant about the importance of all levels of education.

"My work at Southern Wesleyan ties together a lot of my passions. I want to help people improve their lives through higher education," Shelton said.

In addition to his work at the university, Shelton serves as a trustee for the Pickens County School Board. He has been a trustee for four years, served two years as chairman and is currently vice-chairman.

Shelton had a number of other careers before beginning his current role as regional director for the adult program at the university's Central location. He earned his bachelor's degree in textile engineering at Clemson University, then worked with several textile manufacturing companies. He also worked as a process engineer in the automotive industry and published a newspaper in his hometown, Dacusville, S.C.

"I spent so many years in manufacturing and engineering. It was lucrative, but it wasn't fulfilling. When I jumped into public service, I was searching for employment in some part of the field of education," he said.

Shelton is grateful to work with a university that has such a strong economic and social impact, he said.

"Southern Wesleyan University impacts this area spiritually, culturally and economically. Part of what we are is a missions program. When we educate students and send them back into the world to educate others, then they, in turn become missionaries," Shelton said.

"There are so many cultural events on our campus. Most are open to the public and, in many cases, they are free. We present wonderful events at our Newton Hobson Chapel and Fine Arts building. So many people come here to enjoy offerings from Southern Wesleyan University to the public. That's part of our mission, too," he said.

Now is a particularly good time for adults to consider earning a college degree, Shelton said.

"Anytime is a good time to attend Southern Wesleyan, but right now in particular, the degree programs we offer make people more marketable," he said. "If two applicants are competing for a job and one has that degree and the other doesn't, we've given our graduate a leg up."

In his free time, Shelton enjoys studying history.

"I'm a real history buff. I love history and I love Carolina. I'm a real Carolina boy," he said. Shelton and his wife, Ginger, have two children: John, 23, and Caroline, 15. John is enrolled in the adult program at Southern Wesleyan. The family attends Dacusville United Methodist Church.

Shelton is also active in a number of community groups. He founded the Dacusville Business association in 2006, served two years as president and serves as a board member. Shelton served several years as a board member and president for the Dacusville Little League and currently serves on the board for the Pickens County chapter of the American Red Cross.

In addition to the local school board, Shelton is serving on two statewide boards: the Board of Directors for the South Carolina School Boards Association and the board for the South Carolina School Board Insurance Trust Corporation.

"I enjoy serving on community boards. To me, public service is a calling," Shelton said. "I hope I do a good job and that people trust my judgment."


